- 🌐 VOP - Planning performances in China for Voice Over Piano Team and Associate Member, Lion Thomas and Sara for international and cultural musical events with the goal to raise funds for service projects.
- 🌐 Youth Exchange Programs - Provide tours and transportation and volunteer as host families for these foreign students visiting Bay Area. Hopefully some U.S. students will be visiting other countries as well.
- 🌐 LCI Convention at Singapore – Lions from Multi-Clubs will attend this together with side tours around China. Great opportunity to share ideas/projects.

🌐 **Chartering Silicon Valley Cyber Leos Club (12- <19 years old)**

- LCI approved our Application on 6/10/19, within a week instead of 4-6 weeks.
- Recruited the most qualified Leo in our District to be the Charter Leo President. She is the 2018-19 Leos District Governor, Leo Elise Kratzer.
- This will be a cyber base Leos club with members locally and globally from schools and communities.
- This club will include new innovative programs including accepting mentally challenged children.
- Leos members will serve and will also have opportunities to learn online classes provided by professionals.

🌐 **Lions of Life Program**

- *Aeta Humanitarian Mission* with Lions of Guangdong, China, Philippines, U.S. This year's focus will be to drive deep water wells at 13 villages and provide storage and delivery system and complete the installation of 80 more solar outdoor lamps, solar pumps.
- Drilling should commence within the next couple of months, awaiting for transfer fund from Chinese Council of Lions Club. SVCLC is proud to be a project partner and with the support of Lion Michael, the project Chairperson supporting Lion Yumei Guan the Leader of the Project. \$60K LCI Foundation matching grant will be used to purchase drilling rig and components.
- Others Aeta programs include vitamin/medication for worms, projectors for teachers, RAM pumps, etc.
- Continue to work with LiveLeaf CEO to get LifeDrop/Rescue doses for children globally. Need more funding.
- LOL Program is supported by Legacy Through Giving Foundation, the current Foundation arm of SVCLC.

🌐 **Projects to Benefit Clubs and LCI/LCIF**

- Continue to “push” Lions Clubs International Foundation to realize the importance of getting 501 c3 Group Exemption for Lions Clubs in the U.S. to get more donations for service projects and support LCIF.
- Continue to input and work with LCI to improve myLion app for filing of Service Activity Reports with myLion app and recommended this responsibility to program chairs instead of club secretary.
- Continue to work with LCI management to setup new AlphaMega Leos Club with 14-24 year old students.
- Work with LCI to reinstate D2D Twinning.

- One of our club members, has been appointed to be the co-chair for the Global Service Team.
